DISCUSSION GUIDE

This discussion guide is meant to be used as a simple, three-step tool to help your small group dive deeper into God's Word, nurture conversation, and draw your group nearer to Christ. As a leader, begin your group in prayer by asking the Holy Spirit to lead your discussion.



WATCH

Watch *Disciples* with your small group and allow time for reflection and observation after the film is finished.

STEP 1



READ

Read Ephesians 2:1-10 out loud with your group and allow time for reflection and observation of the passage of Scripture.

ASK

1. Verses 1-3 discusses being "dead in trespasses and sins" and "children of wrath". What does that mean?

2. Just as Anderson shared his sins in the film, what trespasses has God rescued you from? (Encourage openness and honesty)

3. Verse 5 Paul writes that God, "made us alive together with Christ". Does he mean that in this life, the life to come, or both?

4. If we are saved by grace, when verse 10 states that we are "created in Christ Jesus for good works", what does that mean and what implications does it have on your life today?
