## SMALL GROUP STUDY GUIDE

2. Verse 7 says that Christ "emptied himself by taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men". What comforts did Christ give up, and how did He serve you by becoming human?
3. Christ served you further still by being obedient to death on a cross to give you true life in Him. How does His sacrifice confront your comforts in Question 1?
4. Anker and Tine served others with the Gospel because Christ served them. Take a moment and ask God to help you do the same.
